### Home – Wellington (D)

- Stop at **Hokitika's Greenstone factories**.
- Visit the famous **Pancake Rocks** and **Blow Holes**.

## Day 10 – Monday 21st

### **Punakaiki – Kaiteriteri (B,D)**

- Follow the mighty Buller River to the Buller Gorge Adventure and Heritage Park and experience New Zealand’s longest **Swing Bridge** and ride the **High Speed Comet Line**.

### Acceptance Of Terms & Conditions

If you have booked a tour with us and paid your deposit, you are deemed to have accepted these terms. Prior to the tour commencing the students and parents of students joining the tour will need to have signed a Weir Tours behavioural agreement. This agreement outlines expectations of student behaviours whilst on tour.

### Itineraries

The Itinerary for your tour package was correct at the date and time of printing however it is subject to change without notice. Your itinerary could change due to road or weather conditions, changes imposed by other tour operators or a range of other factors beyond our control. You agree that we have no liability to you for changes to your itinerary.

### Itinerary Variations

Weir Tours reserves the right to vary the itinerary with no additional charge or refund to you where circumstances beyond Weir Tours control make changes necessary (eg. cancellation of activities due to weather, breakdowns).

### Price Amendments

Prices were correct at the time and date of printing; however, Weir Tours NZ reserves the right to amend the price subject to any changes in price imposed by other tour operators and carriers included in the itinerary or increases in government or other levies.

### Price does not include

Transport including flights to and from the point of where you will be joining the tour if required. Personal expenses such as additional meals, beverages, optional activities, souvenirs, phone and laundry charges.

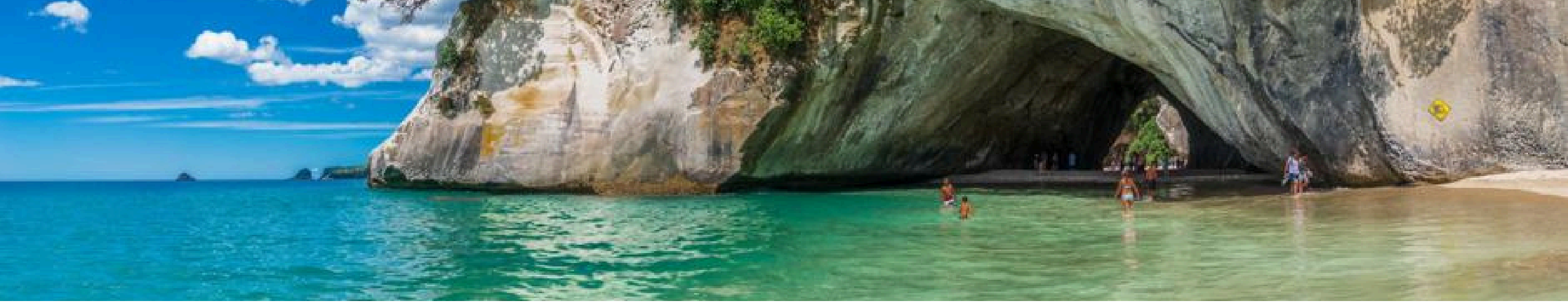
### Health & Fitness

### Permission Forms

You will need written permission from your natural parents to join the tour and to participate in optional activities. Your parents need to complete and submit the permission form before the start of the tour. This is a Weir Tour requirement to participate in the optional activities being offered.





## Terms & Conditions

(Applicable for New Zealand Tours 01 January 2024- 31 December 2025)

### Health & Safety Information including COVID-19

At Weir Tours NZ our first priority is your safety and enjoyment while you are travelling with us. While we have always maintained a high standard of cleaning on our coaches, due to Covid 19 we have increased the frequency of which we do this when we are traveling on tours to ensure your safety. Hand sanitiser will be provided, and we ask that you maintain government standards in terms of hygiene practices, this includes washing or sanitising hands frequently.

For the health and safety of all passengers and staff on tour, any passengers showing symptoms of illness (such as fever, coughing or difficulty breathing) will not be accepted onboard the coach unless they can provide a negative Covid-19 test result received within the past 24 hours.

Should any passenger start to feel unwell on arrival or while on tour, they must immediately advise their Tour Manager and may be required to visit a medical practitioner/medical centre/hospital. To continue the tour the passenger must provide a negative Covid-19 test and be deemed fit and well to participate fully on a coach tour. Any costs incurred will be at the passenger's own expense.

### Removal From Your Package Tour

For the wellbeing of all passengers on your packaged tour, Weir Tours reserve the right to remove you from the tour and cancel your booking with us if you breach any of your obligations under the terms provided that, except in the case of a serious breach (as determined by Weir Tours' representatives) we will give you notice of your breach and a reasonable opportunity (which will be no more than 24 hours) to remedy the breach before exercising our cancellation right. In the case of a serious breach, as per your student behavioural agreement with Weir Tours. Weir Tours have the right to exclude you from the tour and cancel your booking by immediate, verbal, or written notice to you. In the event of such cancellation, you will be responsible, at your cost, for arranging any accommodation or travel costs and other matters as required as a direct or indirect consequence of the cancellation. In the event of removal from a tour no refund will be given.

### Travel Insurance

Weir Bros strongly advises all passengers to purchase travel insurance when booking a tour. A comprehensive travel insurance policy gives peace of mind for unexpected issues or emergencies that may arise prior to or during a tour. Weir Tours cannot be held responsible for your failure to obtain Insurance which is appropriate, and we recommend you purchase your insurance at the time of, or soon after, booking your trip. Weir Tours will not be held liable for any costs incurred resulting from your failure to obtain adequate travel insurance.

### Facebook/Photo Waiver

By agreeing to the Terms and Conditions, any photographs taken on tour by Weir Tours staff or provided to Weir Tours by you, including photographs with you in them, may be used by Weir Tours for promotion work and advertising, including website, Facebook and other media.

### Lost Property

Please ensure that your property is named and keep valuables on your person or locked away. Weir Tours reserve the right to dispose of any property that is left at the end of the tour, or returned to Weir Tours and not claimed within 2 months from completion of your tour.

### Personal Responsibility

Weir Tours and its representatives take all practicable steps to identify and minimise potential dangers for all participants on tour. However, to the extent permitted by law, Weir Tours, its staff, and management do not accept any liability for any accident or injury to you or your property.

Weir Tours reserve the right to withdraw you from an activity if, in our opinion you are likely to endanger yourself or others. Weir Tours also reserve the right to cancel any activity if we become concerned for any reason for your safety or that of any other person.

You must notify the Weir Tours Tour Manager or another representative of Weir Tours if you are concerned for your safety while on tour.

### Payments, Cancellations & Refunds

A deposit is required at the time of booking to confirm your seat. The balance of all payments must be received by Weir Tour NZ prior to or on the date specified for final payment. Payments are available to be made by Cash, Eftpos / Credit or Direct Debit via the account number supplied on the payment form. Please note if paying via credit card you will incur a fee of 3% on top of original price. Weir Tours NZ reserves the right to amend or reschedule the tour due to the result of circumstances outside the company's control. Weir Tours NZ also reserves the right to cancel the tour due to insufficient numbers and in this instance a substitute date may be offered, or a full refund will be made available. Tour Prices exclude drinks, travel insurance or items of personal nature.

### Cancellation Policy

All cancellations must be received in writing and will be subject to a cancellation fee. The written cancellation must be signed by your host parent.

If after your booking has been made and you wished to cancel:

25-30 Days prior to tour commencement you will forfeit your deposit.

14-25 Days Prior to tour commencement you will forfeit 60% of the tour price (40% refund) plus any applicable supplier cancellation fees.

0-14 Days prior to tour commencement you will forfeit 100% of your tour price (No Refund)

There will be no refund on flight purchases under any circumstances.
